BILL OF RIGHTS

We are Abolitionistas! This is our code. Repeat after me...

- 1 I have the right to walk away from any situation that feels creepy, unsafe or inappropriate.
- 2 I have the right to tell anyone to stop touching me or to leave me alone, and I have the right to make this demand as loudly as I can, especially if other people are nearby.
- **3** I have the right to tell an adult whom I trust if someone touches me in inappropriate or unsafe ways.
- **4** I will be on the lookout for predators who intend to harm my friends, my sisters, or my brothers.
- **5** I will not give my personal information online or meet face-to-face with someone I have met online.
- 6 I will save the number of the National Human Trafficking Hotline to my phone: 1-888-373-7888.
- 7 I will make a list of adults I can go to for help (including parents, teachers, religious leaders, police officers) and save their contact information in my phone.
- **8** I will talk with a trusted adult if a friend shows some of the most typical danger signs of being trafficked:
 - stops going to school
 - ▶ starts dressing in clothes that are too mature
 - ▶ loses interest in normal activities
 - ▶ shows visible signs of abuse
 - ▶ hangs out with older men
 - ▶ has multiple phones or pagers
 - ▶ contracts STDs, or becomes pregnant
 - ▶ begins talking about sexual activities
 - ▶ becomes depressed and withdrawn
- **9** I will live a life of courage, power, and inspiration.



WHAT IS "GROOMING"?

"Grooming" is the first step a trafficker uses to brainwash their victim. A trafficker takes control of a person by becoming friends or even the boyfriend of that person. Then they use this relationship to force their victim into sex slavery.

WHO DO TRAFFICKERS TARGET?

- ▶ Runaways
- ▶ Unhappy young people, and young people with social media accounts
- Missing persons
- Homeless children
- Children in foster care
- Victims of domestic violence

HOW DO TRAFFICKERS EARN TRUST?

- ▶ Traffickers sometimes make friends with their targets through social media.
- ► They often pretend to be someone they're not, like a young girl or someone else who seems harmless.
- ▶ When a trafficker meets a target, they start a friendly conversation. This is how they learn to control the victim.

THEY MEET A VICTIM'S BASIC NEEDS TO GAIN CONTROL

- ► Traffickers give food, shelter or protection to the target, so that their victims have to depend on them.
- ▶ Traffickers promise paid work, or give gifts or experiences to their target.
- ► They give their target warmth or friendship so that the target will trust them and not want to leave them.

HOW DO TRAFFICKERS ISOLATE YOUNG PEOPLE?

- ► A trafficker keeps their victim away from their friends and family or anyone who can help them. The target trusts them and goes along with it.
- ► Traffickers say hurtful things to their victims and make them think they are worthless and that no one else can love them.

HOW TRAFFICKERS USE FORCE AND ABUSE

- Traffickers hurt victims. Sometimes they threaten to hurt their victims' families. These are examples of force and coercion.
- ▶ They make victims feel unloveable in order to keep them obedient and alone.
- Traffickers force targets to do things through threats of violence (also called "coercion") or physical abuse (also called "force").



MY ACTION PLAN

THE SEXUAL TRAFFICKING OF CHILDREN IS SLAVERY. BECOME AN ABOLITIONISTA!

If someone under 18 has a pimp or "manager" and has sex for money, that person is a victim of human trafficking.

FOR HELP CALL 1-888-373-7888.

Then, immediately tell a parent, teacher, police officer, school counselor, pastor, priest, rabbi, or other religious leader, or any adult you know and trust, and keep talking to people until someone takes action.

IF YOU OR SOMEONE YOU KNOW IS IN IMMEDIATE DANGER, CALL 911.

HERE IS WHAT A VICTIM OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING LOOKS LIKE:

- A young person who has sex for money.
 (The law considers this human trafficking.)
- **2.** An immigrant whose I.D. or travel documents have been taken away. (A typical sign of human trafficking.)
- **3.** Someone who is being threatened and manipulated because they owe money to their boss.

 (This is a kind of slavery.)
- **4.** Someone who is being forced to stay at a job that they want to leave. (This is another type of slavery.)
































































































































