Categories of Aid

Food Security (FS) - All food bought, feeding or nutritional programs started (including monies from Restricted funds that went to support these)

Health (H) - Value of medical supplies, medicines and hygiene kits delivered

Education (E) - Value of school kits and supplies (including those donated for Operation Iraqi children)

Community Development (CD) - Value of what we have delivered at housing or agricultural projects, computers provided, wells, vocational training programs, etc.

Disaster Relief (DR) - Value of aid donated for emergency relief such as tents, water purification units, blankets, food, etc. **Child Welfare (CW)** - Values of toys, shoes and clothing we delivered (Care Bags, gifts and party supplies)
