Sustainability Start-up Idea Competition

Student acts as Founder of a Social Entrepreneurship Project to:

- Pick any one of the 17 UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) for a business idea development
- Assume the role of entrepreneurs who want to create a digital start-up organization (a company or NGO) in that SDG related area to solve problems related to environment, social, or any other sustainable development issues
- Create a start-up act as a founder, and will need to assume a key role
- Develop a pitchbook detailing: mission and vision, company registration, a broader business plan, board structure, fund raising, team responsibilities and hiring, list of various operations
- Present a one-year plan (1 page) describing plan of activities

PAI since launch: Pilot 2020 by NYIF



Launch in 2020

- The PAI was formally launched on 26th December 2020, with the first session on the high-level overview of Macro and Microeconomics fundamentals.
- Delivered by senior NYIF faculty and Northwestern University alum, Mr. Jimmy Pang this first session attracted nearly 160 registered participants from 15 countries worldwide.

Since then, PAI has successfully

- engaged leading schools as PAI partners
- attracted 360 students participated in live sessions and 950 students registered to watch playback;
- organised eight more sessions, related to three categories of:
 - a) developing basic financial skills
 - b) understanding the financial industry and how to benefit from it
 - c) starting your own business




