### **Day one**

Arrival in Guatemala city and transport to Antigua. Free rest of the day.

We will deliver a bunk bed and linens to a family and visit orphanage (Por Amor de Patricia)

Free afternoon to visit Antigua (optional walking tour)

Welcome dinner (included)

### **Day 3**

We will paint a house built for a poor family by construcasa

Shop and delivery of food to free kitchen run by nuns and home for abandoned elderly.

#### Day 4

We will travel to Panajachel with a long stop in a hilltop community to deliver goats and put finishing touches to vented stoves.
